

B. Lane MacDonald

FMR Diversified Investments President and Chief Investment Officer

Lane MacDonald is the President and Chief Investment Officer of FMR Diversified Investments having previously served in a similar role at The Crosby Group ("Crosby"). In his current role, Lane oversees Diversified Investments across the FMR platform including Private Equity, Natural Resources and Real Estate. Prior to joining Crosby in 2014, Lane spent six years in various leadership roles at Harvard Management Company ("HMC"), which manages Harvard University's \$33 billion endowment. Most recently, Lane was the Managing Director of the Private Equity Group at HMC managing more than \$7 billion of investments globally across several strategies including venture capital, growth equity and leverage buyouts. His responsibilities included overseeing all fund and direct investments within Private Equity as well as managing HMC's energy investment portfolio. Previously, Lane spent two years leading the Public Markets Group at HMC where he managed more than \$7 billion of investments across a variety of asset classes including global equities, high yield and public commodities.

Lane was previously a General Partner at Alta Communications for eight years where he focused on originating and managing private equity investments in the media, internet and telecom services industries. Prior to Alta, he worked at J.W. Childs Associates, a private equity firm specializing in leverage buyouts and recapitalizations of middle market growth companies. Earlier in Lane's career, he worked at BancBoston Capital (the private equity division of BankBoston) and Robertson Stephens & Company (an investment bank focused on emerging growth companies).

Lane graduated with honors from Harvard University with a degree in Economics and received an MBA from the Stanford Graduate School of Business. Lane was also a member of the 1988 U.S.A. Olympic Hockey Team.
